on the formation of the Diggers Memorial Bowls Club

19th of June 1972

MINUTES OF a meeting (Special) of the Diggers Bowls Club, held in Tobruk House
on the afternoon of Monday the 19th of June at 5.30 p.m.

PRESENT G. Meares (Chairman) A Underhill, R. Harald, C. Jarvis, H. Tipping,
N. Drescher, P. Tarrt, B. Challands, and Hon Sec

Business The Chairman explained that the purpose of the meeting which had been duly
advertised in the previous Thursdays "Diggers Doings" was to get some direction
as to whether we would go ahead in building our own green. After a lengthy
discussion it was decided that we would proceed with the project. In the dis-
cussion the opinion was expressed that the Diggers Club was the only Club in the
City to have the prospects of completing the project, and that the City was
badly in need of another two greens.

Membership It was pointed out that present members would most likely adhere to their
present Club and that intirely new members would have ti be recruited. This
would mean a completely new set of rules.

Finance It was suggested that the initial finance could be supplied by members them
selves by selling debentures to our 120 members at \$100 each. The Sec said that
one member had offered to supply finance up to \$2000 if the project took off the
ground.

It was also suggest that Walter Reid and Co could be approached to gaurantee
a loan of \$60,000 at the Bank.

Trustees It was suggested that we continue our allegiance to the R.S.L. by asking
the R'ton Sub Branch Trustees to also be the trustees of the Club

Building It was suggested that the initial ta get be for a Club House and one green
at a suggested cost of \$50,000

Deputation The Hon Sec was instructed to approach the C.Q.D.B.A. President Len Talbot,
Doug Ha gh, Tony Lynham, and Andy Clark to form a deputation to the Lands
Commissioner when he visited the Coty later in the month, to discuss getting
one and one third acres of land in the immediate vicinity of the North R'ton
Swimming Pool.

This being all the business the meeting closed at 6.15 p.m.
